

Traffic Management Companies

Traffic management plan (TMP) prepared by a qualified person as required by the Road Management Act 2004 and Road Safety Act 1986 must be supplied when working on any Council road, footpath, nature strip or laneway. There are no exemptions to this and a TMP is to accompany all applications.

The plan must be site specific and include the details of how you propose to place, erect, dismantle and/or undertake the proposed works. All works are to be clearly delineated and signed in accordance with the relevant Acts, Regulations, Australian Standards, and Codes of Practice.

Principals, employers and persons in control of workplaces have a statutory duty of care to provide a safe workplace for all personnel working on a worksite, accessing the site or impacted by the construction activity including employees, contractors, subcontractors, visitors to the site and the general public (Road Management Act 2004).

You may use any Traffic Management company to obtain a TMP. However, if you are unsure where to start, here is a list of companies that can assist you:
