Do you care for a partner, friend or family member with health or other support needs? Are you part of the LGBTI community – or do you care for someone who is?

Yarra City Council is funded to provide respite care to the LGBTI community through the Support for Carers program. You can be a carer for someone living with disability or for an older person with care needs.

Each successful applicant will receive up to 20 hours respite care per year.

Our staff are trained to be respectful and sensitive to you or your family's preferences and care needs.

Areas covered include the municipality of Yarra and surrounding suburbs.

How the service is used is up to you. We can provide a regular or occasional service; either within the home or out in the community.
