These elements are limited to: Lighting, Signage, Display Shelving.

The funding would support the purchase and installation of specialist lighting. Galleries require flexible lighting systems, which are accurate and consistent in their colour temperature and produce light with high colour fidelity. The scope of the Lighting includes linear lighting and adjustable track lighting, allowing an inviting wash of light throughout the space and spot lighting of individual objects, which is an important consideration.

The Signage includes street level Wayfinding and Promotional signage, visible from Easey Street and inside the building. This is a combination of printed and cut vinyl.

The Shelving is intended to display and store design objects during and between exhibitions, fixed to the internal walls.
