1. Introduction

Chair gave an Acknowledgment of Country and acknowledged members not present (apologies).

2. YAARTS Membership Update

Members were reminded that this was the final year of their term. Terms of Reference were being updated from 6 to 8 members. Expressions of Interest for the 2024-2026 YARRTS panel to be advertised end of the year. Members were thanked for their contribution so far and encouraged to reapply if interested and/or promote this opportunity to their networks.

3. Confirmation of previous minutes

4. Arts and Culture Grants

Members were informed of grant open dates, upcoming assessment date and process:

- Arts Fellowship Grant: applications opened 12 June 31 July for outcome 2024 (One \$10k grant to support a creative in their practice for the year. Open to all artforms. Not project driven)
- Annual grants (round1) applications opened 12 June 31 July
- Small Project Grants: application open 1 July (up to \$2k pool \$70k)
- Sustainability Arts Grants: application open 1 July (\$1k grants to help projects be more sustainable through goods and services)
- Room to Create Responsive Grants applications open 1 July No changes \$25k
- Assessment September 6

5. State and Federal Budgets

- Members were given a breakdown of State and Federal budgets in relation to arts funding. In this current round, funding leaned towards large arts organisation, music, and film.
- Discussion revolved around local government's investment in the Arts in comparison to State and Federal contributions with statistics gathered from ANA Arts Think Tank report The Big Picture 3 -Expenditure on Artistic, Cultural and Creative Activity by Governments in Australia in 2007-08 to 2020-21

6. Public Art Policy

Members were given a hard copy of the current Art in Public Places Policy (which is up for review) and asked to provide feedback (suggestions/ideas) for the new policy by next meeting.

7. Working Group Updates - Visual Arts Panel (VAP) and Room to Create Panel (RTC)

- VAP: Members were informed that that the last meeting was hosted and held at Meridian Sculpture in Fitzroy. The VAP panel and YAARTS members had a discussion around the public art work *Fallen Fruit* with artist Adam Stone and put forward recommendations for the work; to be reported back to the General Manager and CEO for further action/direction.
- RTC: Members were informed that that the last meeting was hosted by Kin Fashion at Peel Street Studios. Members were updated with the balance of the RTC fund, spaces finishing (Collingwood Yards and Argyle St./Piccolo Development), current spaces open and opening of new spaces (Alfasi/560 Church Street).

Business Unit Manager Siu Chan notified members that she was finishing up at Yarra after 20 years of service. She thanked them for their support as did the members in return.
